Mrs. Gibson replied, this would be the Council's decision to approve the Resolution just to pay the Attorney fees. Mayor Cole made a motion to approve Resolution #2016-18, for contractual services for the Attorney fees, move \$40,000 from contingency into legal services for contractual services for the remainder of the year; Motion by Councilwoman Thomas, the motion was seconded by Councilman Washington; **AYE:** Mayor Cole, Vice Mayor Daniels, and Councilman Washington; **NAYE:** Councilwoman Thomas; **MOTION PASSES.** Mayor Cole put a motion on the floor to move \$20,000 from Contingency for Planning; Motion by Councilman Daniels, the motion was seconded by Councilman Washington; **AYE:** Mayor Cole; Vice Mayor Daniels, and Councilman Washington; **NAYE:** Councilwoman Thomas; **MOTION PASSES.**

WASHINGTON- NO REPORT

DANIELS- Happy 4th of July to everyone; look forward to the Town having a Red, White, and Bomb. Happy Birthday wishes to my cousin, sister, she was my inspiration for playing basketball.

THOMAS- Deputy Jenkins, we are having a restore your rights on 7/8/16 expungement, or get your records sealed; restore rights from 2-7 pm at the gym for

anything that you might have on your record that might be holding you back. On July 12, 2016, from 6:30 – 8PM at the Denton Johnson Center; Representative Cortes will give an update on the budget, the paper for the Town was not all completed for the one million dollars; the funds are still available. I have scheduled several other meetings; one with the President of Valencia College in reference to a work program that they will be bringing back.

COLE- outstanding bill, Gunster Law Firm for an opinion of the Charter that was done by Mayor Grant; Ordinance 2008-6, reads that anything over \$2,000 needs Council approval; anything over \$5,000 must have formal sealed competitive procedures, need to deal with this, find out the wishes of the Council. Mayor Cole asked Attorney Morrell is the Town obligated to pay this bill; Attorney Morrell replied yes, the Attorney is outside the bidding process, you can look at it as a personal relationship; the only time the bidding process is used is to keep it fair and competitive. In the Florida Statute Attorneys and Accountants are exempt. Mayor Cole asked that Attorney Morrell give this to Council in writing. A copy of the contract with given to Council. In reference to the floats ten; \$5,000 that was not in the budget; were they billed to the CRA or the Town asked Mayor Cole. Ms. Gibson replied the CRA has a line item for events; this should have come to the CRA Meeting before the parade. The last Council meetings have been good, didn't want to bring some things up; because of fliers that went out, we put ourselves in a bad position, the trade mark for the Orlando Predators was put on the flier; as well as the NBA, and the Boys and Girls Club, I will do damage control on this. With the Boys and Girls Club, we still have the \$5,000 outstanding; it cannot be used for another trip, without prior approval from Town Council, there has been no other letter sent out to the Boys & Girls Club. These labels that are on the fliers came from Town Hall; for the record all of these were made by Anthony Grant, this is being dealt with as we speak, this was made downtown at the City of Orlando, there will be consequences; people that work here that want to be a part of this, there will be casualties. If you have any recommendations on the Ordinance for the CRA, please give this information to Ms. Williams. The Resolution for appointing members to our boards will be on the next Agenda, the people appointed to our boards, it is important that they know what they are doing, and they are versed. The Code Enforcement Board that Ms. Washington and I are putting together will be residents that believe in Code Enforcement. If there is anything that Council wants to see done to get you more active, get this information to Ms. Williams or Ms. Fort, so we can get these things done. Mayor Cole wished Ms. Williams a Happy Birthday!

MORRELL- Rhonda Anderson vs. Town of Eatonville lawsuit has been dismissed. Mayor Cole asked Attorney Morrell the status of the Oak Haven Law Suit; Attorney Morrell replied he does not have information on this, it is being handled by Florida League of Cities. Ms. Gibson indicated this matter was resolved during Ms. Andrews tenure with the Town. Mayor Cole requested to receive a copy of this letter regarding Oak Haven.
