SECOND PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The Town of Eatonville plans to apply to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) for a Community Development Block Grant-Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) of \$1,078,600.00. For each activity that is proposed, at least 70% of the funds must benefit low-and-moderate income persons. The activities, dollar amounts and estimated percentage benefit to low-and-moderate income persons for which the Town of Eatonville is applying are:

Service Area #1 Town Wide Service Area and Project Area:

The activities to be carried out in Project Area #1 are as follows:

The duplex building, located at 213 West Kennedy Boulevard in Eatonville, is currently being utilized by the Eatonville Chamber of Commerce on one side and is being utilized for COVID testing and vaccinations on the separate side of the building. The Town proposes to apply for and utilize CDBG-CV assistance to make improvements to the portion of the structure currently providing COVID testing and vaccinations. This will provide residents with a safe, handicap accessible location to receive these services.

The proposed project budget is as follows:
