



THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE TRASH COLLECTION

CONTAINER PROVIDED - 1 each 95 gallon wheeled cart - trash is **limited to only** what fits in your container. Container should be placed within 3 feet of the curb. Trash should be out the night before or by 6 am day of service.

Service day is TUESDAY



CONTAINER PROVIDED - 1 each 18 gallon bin Recycling is **limited to only** what fits in your bin. Container should be placed within 3 feet of the curb. Recycle should be out the night before or by 6 am day of service.

Service day is WEDNESDAY



NO CONTAINER PROVIDED - White Goods must be placed 3 feet of the curb. Bulk items must be out the night before or by 6 am day of service. (Freon must be removed from Refrigeration units)

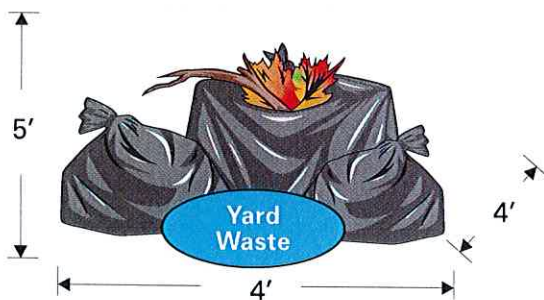

NO CONTAINER PROVIDED - Items are **limited to 3 cubic yards 4'L x 4'W x 5'H** or 10 each lawn bags or an amount not to exceed 3 cubic yards. **Small debris such as leaves, grass clippings and small tree branches should be placed in plastic bags or containers.** Yard waste can be bundled and tied in 4 foot lengths. Each bundle must be 50 lbs. or less normal yard waste only, no large heavy tree stumps or branches exceeding 6 inches in diameter. Yard waste should be out the night before or by 6 am day of service. **NO MORE THAN 3 CUBIC YARDS WILL BE PICKED UP AT ONE TIME.**

Service day is WEDNESDAY



NO CONTAINER PROVIDED - Bulk Items are limited to 3 cubic yards. Bulk items must be placed 3 feet of the curb. Bulk items must be out the night before or by 6 am day of service. **NO MORE THAN 3 CUBIC YARDS WILL BE PICKED UP AT ONE TIME.**

WHY THE CHANGE?

The recycling market has changed. Currently Municipalities are sending recyclables to the landfill, as there has not been a market for them. In an effort to stop sending recyclables to the landfill; We are changing what can and cannot go in your recycling bin/cart.

The new markets are very strict and will not accept anything other than what is listed as **ALLOWED** on this brochure. Current markets only pay for "clean" recycling.

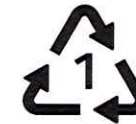
As of October 1st, 2019 bins/carts will be considered "contaminated" if they contain anything other than what is on this list. Paper must now be put into your trash cart. The only cardboard that can be recycled is clean flattened corrugated boxes (not cereal boxes).
