A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, FLORIDA SETTING THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE TAX LEVY OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR ORANGE COUNTY FOR FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2022, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2023, AND REPEALING RESOLUTION #2022-49 THAT APPROVED THE TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022/2023, PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Eatonville, Orange County, Florida repealing Resolution #2022-49 that set the Tentative Millage Rate of 7.2938 mills for fiscal year 2022/2023 and adopting Resolution #2022-51 Final Millage Rate of 7.2938 mills which is more than the rolled back rate of 6.9072 mills by 5.60% has established its final tax levy for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023.

WHEREAS, the Town of Eatonville of Orange County Florida held a public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes is not exempt from taxation within Orange County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the Town of Eatonville as \$276,000,099.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: the final tax levy for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022, and ending September 30, 2023, for the Town of Eatonville is hereby set at a rate of 7.2938 mills which is more than the rolled back rate of 6.9072 mills by 5.60%.

SECTION TWO: the voted debt service millage is -0-.

SECTION THREE: CONFLICTS: All Resolution or parts of Resolutions in conflict with any other Resolution or any of the provisions of the Resolution is hereby repealed.

SECTION FOUR: SEVERABILITY: If any section or portion of a section of this Resolution is found to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section or part of this Resolution.

SECTION FIVE: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution will take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.

SUMMARY Ordinance # 2022-11 is being presented by staff to Town Council to approve the second reading for fiscal year 2022-2023 Town Budget.

The Town of Eatonville of Orange County, Florida set forth the appropriations and revenue estimate for the Budget in the amount of \$6,336,752.

ORDINANCE #2022-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, ORANGE COUNTY FLORIDA, APPROVING ~~THE FIRST READING OF~~ ORDINANCE # 2022-11, THE PROPOSED BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Eatonville of Orange County, Florida on Wednesday, September 7, 2022, held a Public Hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Eatonville of orange County, Florida set forth the appropriations and revenue estimate for the Budget for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 in the amount of \$6,336,752; and

WHEREAS, the Town Charter requires a Budget to be adopted by the third Monday of September each year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE, ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION ONE: The Fiscal Year **2022-2023**, proposed Budget affixed as part of this official document as presented by the mayor pursuant to the Town Charter.

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.

SECTION THREE: BUDGET AMENDMENT: Town Council approving an official Resolution of the Town detailing the proposed amendment(s) to the Budget may amend the Budget after its adoption. Funds may be transferred from within the Departments budget as deemed necessary without Town Council approval by action of this Ordinance.

SECTION FOUR:CONFLICTS: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict in conflict therewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION FIVE: SEVERABILITY: Should any section or part of this Ordinance be declared invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction such adjudication shall not apply to or effect any other provision(s) of this Ordinance, except to the extent that the entire section or part of a section may be inseparable in meaning and intent from the Section to which such holdings shall apply.

SECTION SIX: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and adoption.
